

BITCOIN TRANSACTION CHECKLIST

Investor Success Center • A Before, During & After Checklist for Sending Bitcoin

Bitcoin transactions require care. A cryptocurrency transaction generally cannot be cancelled or reversed after it has been sent and confirmed. Use this checklist before sending Bitcoin—especially when funding a WinVest investment or sending to an address for the first time.

1. Before You Start

- Make sure you understand where the Bitcoin is being sent and why.
- If funding WinVest, obtain the current deposit/investment address from your own WinVest account rather than relying on an old address, screenshot, email, or address supplied by another member.
- Make sure you are sending **Bitcoin (BTC)** using the network/instructions currently specified by the receiving platform.
- Confirm that your wallet or exchange has enough Bitcoin to cover the amount you intend to send plus any applicable network or service fees.

2. Verify the Receiving Address

- Copy and paste the receiving address whenever possible instead of typing it manually.
- After pasting, compare the beginning and ending characters with the address displayed by the intended recipient/platform.
- Check the address again immediately before approving the transaction.
- If the destination or process is unfamiliar, consider a small test transaction first when practical.
- Never substitute an address sent unexpectedly through Telegram, WhatsApp, email, social media, or private message without independently verifying it.

3. Check the Amount & Fees

- Confirm the amount of Bitcoin you are sending.
- Review any network fee or service fee shown by your wallet/exchange.
- Check whether the fee is deducted separately or affects the amount the recipient will receive.
- If funding an investment, make sure the amount that will actually arrive satisfies the current minimum or intended investment amount.

4. Final Check Before You Press Send

- Correct cryptocurrency: Bitcoin (BTC).
- Correct receiving address.
- Correct network/instructions for the destination.
- Correct amount.
- Fees reviewed.
- No one is pressuring me to rush the transaction.
- I understand that once sent, the transaction generally cannot be reversed.

5. After Sending Bitcoin

- Wait for your wallet/exchange to provide a transaction record.
- Locate and save the Transaction ID (TXID) when available.
- Do not panic if the transaction does not appear at the destination immediately; Bitcoin transactions require blockchain confirmations and timing can vary.
- If funding WinVest, allow the platform time to detect and process the transaction according to its current procedures.
- Check your WinVest account rather than relying solely on an email or message saying the investment is active.

6. If the Transaction Appears Delayed

- Check whether your sending wallet shows the transaction as sent, pending, or confirmed.
- Use the TXID to review the transaction on a reputable Bitcoin blockchain explorer if needed.
- Confirm that the receiving address shown in the transaction matches the address you intended to use.

- Allow for blockchain/network congestion and the receiving platform's processing time.
- If the blockchain shows the transaction confirmed but WinVest has not credited it after a reasonable processing period, contact official WinVest Support and provide the TXID and relevant transaction details.
